Answer 11:

As per the information on our [website](#) the “Expressions of Interest and scans of requisite documents must be **signed with a qualified electronic signature** (or signatures, dependent on the legal representation of the party) **verifiable** through the European Commission’s [Digital Signature Service](#)”. EED does not indicate which system should be used for signing the documents with a [qualified electronic signature](#) (or signatures). The signature(s) should only be VERIFIABLE using the indicated public electronic service. It is up to the party/parties participating in the tender to choose their preferred tool to sign the documents. The preferred signature format is [PAdES](#).
